

International Endorsed Programmes: Policy

1 Introduction

NOCN will provide International Endorsed Programme certification outside of the UK for programmes NOCN quality assures and considers provide a good curriculum and content, at an appropriate level, which will support the student in their learning.

These are not 'qualifications' and do not confirm an individual student's achievement. They are quality assured by NOCN and are not regulated by any Qualifications Regulator.

2 Quality Assurance Review

NOCN will review and check the course content and delivery in its approval process for accrediting the International Endorsed Programme in accordance with NOCN's Guidelines.

As part of this NOCN will agree with the Training Centre which, if any, levelling and crediting system will be applied to the course content. This might be a system using in a specific country in which the Centre is based or a pan-country system such as the European Qualifications Framework (EQF).

3 Student Registration

The Training Centre will be responsible for the accuracy of student registration as well as checking identification and eligibility. In addition, the Centre will be responsible for ensuring full attendance on the International Endorsed Programme and shall not register any student with NOCN who has not attended and completed the course.

4 Certification

NOCN will issue an electronic copy of the Certificates for the International Endorsed Programme in a format agreed with the Centre. This will include:

- NOCN logo in the right-hand upper corner;
- Centre logo in the left-hand upper corner;
- Statement "This is to certify that:
- Student's name;
- Statement "has completed the following NOCN International Endorsed Programme of learning";
- International Endorsed Programme title, which would include if relevant any levelling or crediting information, with, as appropriate, the initials or name of the recognised levelling and crediting system (e.g. EQF);



- Statement "A list of modules which confirms the content of this programme is provided overleaf" where this is relevant to the Programme;
- Date certificate issued;
- Certificate No;
- Signature panel; and
- NOCN Endorsed Programme logo in the right-hand lower corner

In the cases where the International Endorsed Programme consists of various modules the Training Centre will be responsible for preparing the supporting attachment to the Certificate listing the module information.

5 Issuing Certificates

The Training Centre will be responsible for printing and issuing the Certificate and any supporting module information and sending it securely to the student.
